

Mail Items allowed/not allowed through the mail at ASGDC (as of 10/2/2020)

1. No stamps, envelopes, note pads, stationery, note books writing tablets, journals or paper allowed
2. No stickers and/or paste allowed on letters or envelopes
3. No magnets or foreign objects allowed
4. US postal money orders only. No cash, checks or cashier's checks
5. All pictures must be 5x7 or smaller, no Polaroid pictures allowed
6. No excessively large items, i.e. greeting cards, boxes, etc.
7. No pasting allowed
8. No excessive amount of materials allowed, i.e. pictures, letters and/or documents/paperwork (**Legal material and/or documents excluded**)
9. No laminated items allowed
10. No credit/debit cards allowed
11. No clothing items or shoes allowed
12. No pictures showing/displaying gang signs, alcohol, flashing cash or blacked out pictures allowed,
13. No internal/dorm pictures of ASGDC allowed
14. All books and/or magazines must be sent directly from a publisher or bookstore
15. No hardback books allowed

16. No drug type magazines allowed, ie marijuana/weed etc.
17. No nude and/or semi-nude pictures allowed
18. No obscene, and/or inappropriate pictures allowed.
No revealing negligee pictures allowed
19. No soaked, stained or items containing any type foreign substance allowed
20. All newspaper subscriptions must be sent through the mail.
21. No inmate carrier newspaper delivery allowed.
Inmates will not receive newspapers sent by newspaper carriers to the lobby or left out front

Four Ways to put money on an inmate's account

1. Mail, using a US postal money order (only)
2. Online using a debit or credit card
3. Use the safe in the lobby to deposit a US postal money order (only)
4. Use kiosk in the lobby: using cash, credit or debit card
